P3 – Leighton Linslade Group

The Parish Path Partnership (P3) is a committee of volunteers who seek to ensure that the footpaths and open spaces in Leighton Linslade are accessible and in good condition. The policy and objectives for the Committee include footpath maintenance, publicity, education, and countryside awareness training. The committee includes representatives from various local groups including The Leighton Buzzard Society, CPRE, the Greensand Trust, The Leighton Buzzard Ramblers, Guides, Knolls Wood Association and various residents associations. P3 seeks to work with partners and communities to encourage projects which are sustainable, inclusive, encourages initiative, and are community and volunteer led. Projects such as hedge laying and footpath clearance have been undertaken with the appropriate tools and training being provided.

The most recent project is the publication of a parish footpath and open spaces map which is available from Leighton Buzzard Library and at the White House in Hockliffe Street.
