

YOUTH FILM CLUB – MEMBERSHIP CARD ALLOCATION INSTRUCTIONS

This is a joint project between CBC and LLTC. It is running as a pilot scheme to see if there is enough take-up for a more long-term investment.

Membership allows a concessionary ticket rate for young people to watch films.

Currently, the films being shown where young people can use the concession are on at 6.00pm. The concession may not be used for other film showings.

Currently, films shown between 5th July and 30 August are open to all age groups however if they do not have youth film club membership, all other ticket sales guidelines apply.

From 13 September to 18 October – the 6.00pm films shown for the club will be for young people between 13 and 17 years of age only and who have membership to the youth film club.

All comments and feedback received will inform the evaluation of the scheme, thank you.

Upon request for membership -

Two pieces of evidence are requested:

1. The household address – to evidence the young person resides within the parish.
2. Evidence of the young person's date of birth. This will inform the expiry date of their membership (13-17yrs).

FAQs

Qu. Why can only young people from the parish be a member?

Ans. The town council is funded by the precept it receives – part of resident's 'RATES' which is collected by Central Bedfordshire Council. The town council is investing the received precept in its residents, not those who do not contribute to the town in this way.

N.B. Some postcodes in Heath & Reach pay to the parish of Leighton-Linslade.

Qu. Why do we record the post code?

Ans. The post code will not identify the 'member', it is requested for evaluation purposes to see where young people come from. This will let us know where to target advertising , e.g. school catchment areas.
