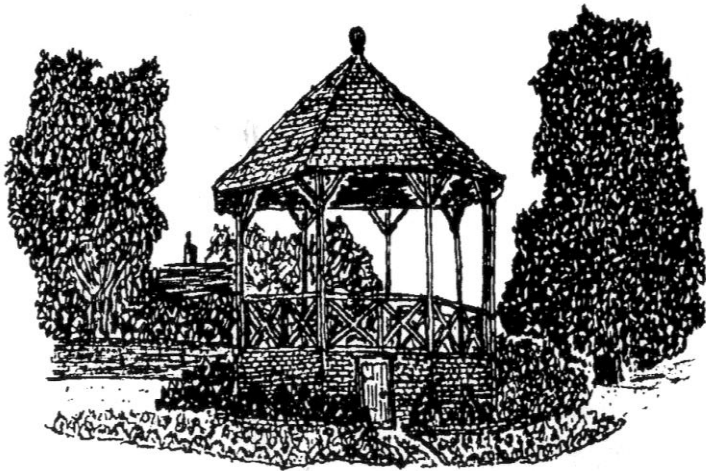

TRANSPORT

HOSPITAL TRANSPORT is limited to patients who meet stringent criteria. Ask the hospital concerned or your GP for contact details.

Please check before planning any journeys mentioned, as timetables and even routes are subject to change.

ACCESS HOSPITAL

- a) **High Wycombe** No.150 bus LB High St. to Aylesbury Bus station then Bay 11 for No. 300 to H.Wycombe – walk through shops to hospital.
- b) **Luton and Dunstable** No. 70 bus (not 70F) from High Street, stops outside hospital.
- c) **Milton Keynes** No. 150 from High Street to MK railway station then local bus, every few minutes, to hospital.
- d) **Stoke Mandeville** No. 150 bus to Aylesbury bus station then Bay 11 for bus to Outpatients at hospital.

AIRPORTS To avoid crossing London if luggage and tube travel are a problem. **L.B. to Heathrow** Leave at Watford Junction and take Green Line 724, bus stand 2 outside station (travel time about 53 mins.) **L.B. to Gatwick** Via Luton on the Brighton Line or LB to Clapham Junction, change platforms (lift) Train times from 03457 484950 (travel time about 1hr. 45 mins)
L.B. to Luton Airport No. 70 bus to Dunstable, change at corner of Church Street onto Arriva bus A
(Travel Line 0871 200 22 33)
