Trade boats offered the chance to purchase handmade items and canal themed memorabilia whilst the historic working boats provided a glimpse into the past and the workings behind the canal in yesteryear.

For those looking to be entertained at the festival, traditional storytellers took to the Lakeside area to delight with traditional tales and yarns whilst stage headliners Funk Odyssey were joined in the Paddocks throughout the day by Stampede, Milady Clare's Musicke, Chasm, Fiona Harrison, Ukietoones and Wayland Smithy band also playing. Traders in the Paddocks area were joined by handcrafters and traditional demonstrators in the craft tent, with a traditional hand-turned funfair providing entertainment for younger visitors.
